Subject: Hood/Suppression Test

Effective Date: Immediately

All mechanical hood/suppression systems must first be pre-tested by installing contractors prior to requesting an inspection from the Building Dept. A pre-test inspection form must be filled out, signed and posted on the hood system and left until inspection is complete. Pre-Test forms can be obtained at the Building Dept.

Inspections must be requested 48 hours in advance of date of inspection. All sub-contractors associated with the hood/suppression system must be on site for inspection, including but not limited to; mechanical, suppression, electrical, gas, fire alarm, general contractor and a representative of the cooking equipment or someone qualified to start up equipment. Upon arrival of inspectors, if system is not ready to be tested or a sub-contractor is not on site within 15 minutes, the inspection will be rejected and a re-inspection must be rescheduled with a 48 hour notice.
