### AN ORDINANCE TO CLOSE AN ALLEY TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC RUNNING NORTH-SOUTH BETWEEN EAST LAFAYETTE AND COLLEGE STREETS

WHEREAS, Downtown Jackson provides substantial quality of life benefits to the City of Jackson and its citizens by providing a center for business, historic context and culture, and a walkable environment; and

WHEREAS, being the heart of Jackson, the level of thru-traffic in Downtown Jackson requires the adjustment of traffic patterns at times to provide for pedestrian safety; and

WHEREAS, the alley running north-south between East Lafayette and College Streets serves as the primary pedestrian way between the College Street Municipal Parking Lot and many businesses in the downtown area; and

WHEREAS, closing the alley to vehicular traffic would increase pedestrian safety and provide an opportunity for the alley to be used for other events and activities when necessary; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Tennessee Code Annotated § 13-4-104, the City of Jackson Planning Commission, has reviewed the proposed action to close access as described above and recommends that such action be approved by the City Council;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, TENNESSEE:

SECTION 1. The vehicular traffic access to a north-south alley running between East Lafayette and E College Streets from Arlington Avenue and vehicular is hereby closed to thru-traffic by such means as determined and implemented by the City all as shown on the schematic drawing affixed hereto as Exhibit A.

## ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, TENNESSEE, AMENDING THE FY 21 BUDGET ORDINANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson governing body recognizes that in order to continue to provide the level of police protection services expected by the citizens of Jackson, there is a need to replace and add certain police vehicles;

### NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF JACKSON, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:

**SECTION 1**: That the City of Jackson governing body proposes to amend the duly approved FY21 Budget Ordinance to include in the Capital Outlay Fund, lease purchase proceeds to fund the acquisition of certain police vehicles in an amount not to exceed \$2,000,000.

**SECTION 2**: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with any provision of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3**: That this ordinance shall take effect the date that it is approved on second reading.

The Jackson Police Department is submitting a proposal to lease/purchase 31 police package fleet vehicles through the Ford Leasing Program. The new vehicles will replace much of our aging fleet of which over 70% have above average mileage. Due to the age and high mileage, several of these cars may be out of service and at the garage at the same time. This leaves the patrol shifts with a shortage of vehicles for officers to use. They often have to wait in the police building until an officer on the prior shift returns their unit. This leads to many of the cars being used 24 hours a day or days at time. The police units that are aged and have high mileage also lead to a safety issue for the officers using them. We are not seeking a budget increase, as we hope to save money in our vehicle repair and maintenance costs and will cover the remaining cost with unused salary dollars from open patrol division. However, it is our hope that we will not have to cut more positions than we already have.

#### Mr. Pilant:

This proposal constitutes an expression of my interest in purchasing the Property (as hereinafter defined) on the general terms and conditions described herein. The proposed terms and conditions for the purchase and use of the Property are as follows:

- 1. <u>The Property</u>. That certain property having an address at 105, 109, and 111 Church Street, Jackson, TN 38301, land consisting of approximately 7,500 square feet and commonly known as the Rockabilly Plat and the adjacent alley (the "**Property**").
- 2. <u>Execution of Purchase Agreement</u>. Purchaser (or designated entity) is prepared to immediately negotiate a Purchase Agreement diligently and in good faith.
- 3. <u>Purchase Price</u>. Purchaser submits to pay THIRTY THOUSAND and 00/100 (\$30,000.00) Dollars, all cash, in immediately available funds. The purchase price shall be paid by the Purchaser at the closing of the sale of the Property.
- 4. Property Improvements. Purchaser intends to renovate the existing structure and revitalize the green space which is currently expected to require an investment of at least \$500,000.00. Purchaser's aim would be to create a mixed-use space of work, live, play for the property to respect its history but also as a complement to the property Purchaser recently purchased and renovated at 118 N. Liberty Street earlier this year investing more than \$1,000,000.00. Purchaser has had initial discussions with local firms who are familiar with the architecture of Downtown Jackson and the importance of maintaining its importance in the City and in Madison County. Additionally, Purchaser is certain that its proposal will bring additional tax revenue for the city along with new jobs creation.

- 5. <u>As Is.</u> Purchaser assumes and is willing to take the property on an "As Is" basis, subject the City of Jackson insuring there is no Lien or other Indebtedness on the Property at closing.
- 6. <u>No Financing Contingency</u>. Purchaser is prepared to pay all cash for the acquisition of the Property and its obligation to purchase the Property shall not be conditioned in any way on Purchaser's ability to obtain financing.
- 7. <u>Closing Date</u>. The closing of the transaction can occur at any time.
- 8. <u>Due Diligence</u>. From and after the effective date of an award to purchase the Property, it is requested that the City of Jackson allow Purchaser to have access to the Property to investigate and inspect (at Purchaser's sole cost and expense) the legal, physical, economic, and environmental condition of the Property, and the suitability of the Property for Purchaser's intended use thereof.
- 9. <u>Condition</u>. At this time, Purchaser will not have any conditions regarding closing unless otherwise provided for herein.

I would appreciate the opportunity to share the vision for what can become a wonderful "second act" for the Rockabilly property that will attract people, ideas, and commerce.
